

# World Aquatics Championships – Singapore 2025 High Diving Qualification Update

Following the recent cancellation of the World Aquatics High Diving World Cup – Brasilia 2024, there have been important updates to the qualification process for the World Aquatics Championships – Singapore 2025.

#### Qualification

The World Aquatics Championships – Singapore 2025 will be open to all athletes who were approved via the Global Management System (GMS) to participate in the World Aquatics High Diving World Cup – Bahrain 2024 and/or the World Aquatics High Diving World Cup – Brasilia 2024, prior to its cancellation.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

- Approved Athletes: Athletes who were formally approved on the GMS to compete in either or both aforementioned World Cup events will be eligible for qualification.
- **Maximum Athlete Representation**: Each Federation may enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per gender.

This approach ensures that athletes who were originally approved to compete in the cancelled World Cup event are still eligible to participate in the World Aquatics Championships – Singapore 2025.


Additionally, World Aquatics reserves the right to extend wild card invitations to athletes for the Singapore 2025 Championships. Any decisions regarding wild cards will be made and communicated in due course.

#### **Format**

The competition format for the World Aquatics Championships – Singapore 2025 will differ slightly from previous years, with a 4-day competition schedule and one less training day compared to the typical 3-day training and 3-day competition structure. Warm up periods and training sessions will be built in the programme to give as many opportunities as possible for all.

- > Repeat the two optional dives, or choose one or both from a different set of optional dives (must comply with the dive group rules).
- > For Dive 5, start list is a reorder from the results of Dive 1 and Dive 3.
- > For Dive 6, start list is a reorder of results of Dive 1, Dive 3 and Dive 5.

DAY 4: 27 July 2025

#### Men's Finals

### Dive 5 & Dive 6

- > Repeat the two optional dives, or choose one or both from a different set of optional dives (must comply with the dive group rules).
- > For Dive 5, start list is a reorder from the results of Dive 1 and Dive 3.
- > For Dive 6, start list is a reorder of results of Dive 1, Dive 3 and Dive 5.

## **Final Scoring**

The scores from the **required** and **intermediate dives** will carry over into the finals. The final score will be the total of **Dive 1**, **Dive 5**, and **Dive 6**.

### **Prize Money**

All **top 14 finalists** will receive **prize money**. Further details regarding the prize money distribution will be provided in the **World Aquatics Championships Summons**.

### **Competition Regulations**

As per Competition Regulations Rule 2.1.3, this is in line with the following written note:

The THDC may establish a special competition format for the World Aquatics

Championships. The special competition format must be approved by the World Aquatics

Bureau.
