Reference Times and Lane Assignments All heats, slower heats, finals, and main races will generally be conducted across all available lanes (0 to 9). The head referee may implement adjustments in consultation with the delegate and the organizer.

Lane assignments will be based on the best times listed in the 50m rankings maintained by Swiss Aquatics. After the entries are processed, these times will be automatically incorporated into the entry list. Clubs are not required to submit reference times when registering.

Only reference times achieved between 16. July 2023 bis 30. June 2025 will be considered and for relays until the 13. July 2025 (Consideration of results already achieved from the current event).

For relays, the registering club must submit the names of the four swimmers expected to participate. The best times from the rankings for each swimmer will automatically be included, and the relay time will be calculated by summing the individual reference times. If a "lap time" is used for the first swimmer from the rankings, a penalty of 0.5 seconds will automatically be applied.

If times for the second, third, or fourth swimmer are taken from individual events or as the lead swimmer in a relay, a bonus of 0.5 seconds will be applied.

Missing times, better times than those in the rankings, and exceptional cases must be reported by the participating club to Swiss Aquatics before the late registration deadline and supported with official results. Swiss Aquatics will ensure these times are added to the rankings.

#### Adjustments to Reference Times and Exceptional Cases

Clubs must adjust reference times if, due to a swimmer's current form or the relay composition, the expected performance at the competition is slower than the original reference time.

The Swiss Aquatics delegate may accept a verified relay time instead of the calculated reference time if the team composition is similar.

Other exceptional cases must be justified in writing by 7:00 PM on the evening before the competition begins. The Swiss Aquatics delegate will decide on such cases upon review of the submitted documentation.

The Swiss Aquatics delegate also reserves the right to consider additional factors, beyond reference times, when determining heat compositions.

## 9. RECOGNITIONS

Titel	As per Regulation 3.2.3
Medals	For the national swimmers ranked 1 to 3 in the open classification: gold, silver, bronze For the international swimmers ranked 1 to 3 in the open classification: gold, silver, bronze
Victory ceremonies	Clubs are responsible for ensuring that their swimmers appear punctually and in the correct attire for the award ceremonies (Regulation 3.1, Art. 7.10).

## 10. INVOICE

Swiss Aquatics will send an invoice to each participating club after the championship, covering the amounts due for:

- Registration and late entries;
- penalties for failing to meet qualifying times and for no-shows at the start;
- any additional amounts owed.

## 11. ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

Each participant is responsible for their own insurance. The SSCHV and the championship organizer do not provide coverage for accidents, illness, theft, or liability and disclaim any responsibility in these matters.

By registering, clubs commit to ensuring that:

- Their swimmers appear punctually and in the correct attire for the award ceremonies (see Competition Regulations Swimming 3.1, Art. 7.10);
- Their team members wear only clean footwear (light-coloured soles) in the swimming facility.

The use of photographers must be approved by the Swiss Aquatics delegate, Marie-Claire Gurtner. Any requests must be submitted by email to [swimming@swiss-aquatics.ch](mailto:swimming@swiss-aquatics.ch) before the start of the Swiss Summer Championships.

Please note that changes to the program, schedule, and eligibility requirements may occur up to the start of the event. Accordingly, registrations may be rejected until the event begins.
