

## RULES OF THE COMPETITION

1. Athletes from the following nine nations are invited: ESP-GBR-GER-FRA-ITA-NED-NOR-SUI-SWE.
2. Competition format according to World Aquatics Age Group rules.
3. Events:
  - Age Groups A and B
  - 1m, 3m, platform
  - Synchronized 3m diving
4. Each nation may enter:
  - 2 athletes per individual event
  - 1 synchro pair
5. Athletes competing in 1m and 3m must participate in both events.
6. Different athletes may compete in synchronized events.
7. The competition is held as a team event with points allocated according to the established scoring system.
